Bloomfield Educational Foundation Celebrates 25th Anniversary in 2024

Terence Mullane, Chairman of The Bloomfield Educational Foundation, (BEF) announced the Foundation will celebrate their 25th anniversary in 2024.

"The BEF was founded in 1999, by community-minded leaders, Joseph Kliminski, Robert Fetterly and Howard Friedman, with assistance from then Superintendent, Thomas Dowd. Since that time, the BEF has raised over \$2.7 million to support the District with over \$1.7 million in teacher and District-wide grants and scholarships. Many of our scholarship funds will award scholarships well into the future, as the result of many very generous supporters. We have worked very well with the Bloomfield School District to support innovative teaching programs and District-wide initiatives such as Science Fairs, and after school and Saturday programs at the Elementary level, media center upgrades and an outdoor classroom at the middle school, and the offering of free SAT prep classes and AP Tests to be paid for by the BEF at the high school. These are just a few examples of the kinds of support we have given over the past two-and-a-half decades," informed Mullane.

The BEF mission states the main goal of the organization is to enhance the educational opportunities for all students in the Bloomfield School District. This is accomplished by teachers and administrators submitting grant requests for funding of various projects that are not covered by the District budget. Additionally, high school seniors are encouraged to fill out scholarship applications for scholarship funding to help defray the cost of a college, vo-tech or other additional learning experience after high school. The BEF is currently offering 30 scholarships, ranging from \$500 to \$5000 a piece, and totaling \$65,000, which will be awarded at the June 2024 ceremony.

The BEF will kick off their 25th anniversary year with a \$50,000 gift to the high school to fund an E-Sports Arena. E-Sports is video gaming done at a professional level. Individuals or teams compete against each other through various video games; these are often in organized tournaments with substantial prize pools. Since 2018, when the National Federation of State High School Associations (NFHS) first recognized e-sports as an official sport, more than 8,600 high schools have started video-gaming teams. E-Sports will be a Varsity lettered sport. Many colleges and universities are offering E-Sports Management degrees which could lead to careers in computer programming, and jobs in the gaming industry.

Another program that has received funds over the years is the Vocational Educational Special Training (V.E.S.T) program at Bloomfield High School. The V.E.S.T program services developmentally delayed adolescents and young adults from ages 15 to 21 with the goal of providing the means to make the students independent and employable. This falls under the umbrella of the Bloomfield Educational Foundation, a registered 501-C-3 charity, founded in 1999, to enhance the educational opportunities for all students of the Bloomfield School District. Funds raised from an annual run, the Brookdale ShopRite Tom Fleming Sunset Classic, support this vital program. This year's race will be held on Thursday June 27, 2024 at Foley Field, beginning at 6:30 with a Kids' Sprints competition. The 5 mile race kicks off at 7:30PM.

Additional events scheduled for the 2024 year include an Alumni Basketball Game on Friday, Jan 12th at BHS at 7PM, the Annual Gala, on April 24th at Nanina's in the Park, a Football Tailgate event at Town Pub, and Alumni Basketball Tip Off event at Bella Napoli, in the fall, with dates to be announced.
